

Awards Day & Reception: Best Visible Portraits (Student Art Contest) is part of the Visible Portraits of Light Art Exhibit.

On the opening reception of Visible Portraits of Light Art Exhibit, their will be certificates & cashier's checks awarded to three winners in both age categories. Also, a total of ten honorable mention certificates will be issued. Five certificates in each age category at the Awards Day Reception: Sunday, April. 26, 2024 at 3:30 PM.

RULES: You can draw or paint a portrait of someone, who you believe is a positive light in your life, or your community. Also write a brief overview of why you believe this person is a positive light, and deserves a portrait created by you. This brief statement should be in 200 words or less. The maximum size of the portrait should be no larger than 18"x 24" and, mounted or matted on a black or white board. Framing is allowed, but will not be judged on the quality of frame, - just the art. Also, only prize winners and honorable mention repentant will be allowed the opportunity to participate in the Art Auction. If you plan to participate in the art auctioned, you as the artist will receive 75% of the money from the winning bid for your art. The remaining 25% will go to support next year's student art contest. **MOST IMPORTANT:** You must check the box on the entry form for your art to be allowed to participate in the 2024 Amazing Art Auction.

SPECIAL NOTICE: All students, whose art is selected as winners & honorable mentions will be displayed with the 12 amazing portraits by master portrait artist Larry Walker, who is nationally known as **The Amazing Mr. Walker**. The 12 featured portraits are oil painting of local pastors, who are serving their community as a positive & visible light. All student art work will be available for pick up one week after the exhibit closes. Only one entry per student. Bring all art entries of the person you selected to draw or paint to:
